#### **Exhibitor Applications**

Application deadline is Friday, August 15. Payment, along with all required documentation, is due with application. Space is limited, so apply early! We cannot guarantee sale item exclusivity. We reserve the right to reject any application for any reason.

#### **Exhibitor Fees**

Price is for a 10x10 space and includes electric. No generators are allowed.

#### Fees for Coweta Chamber Members

- Business and For-Profit Organizations \$200

#### Fees for Non-Chamber Members

- Non-Profit Organizations (501 c3) \$150

#### For ALL Booth Vendors

All vendors are responsible for their own displays, tables, chairs, backdrops, signs and extension cords for electricity. ABSOLUTELY NO DRILLING into the pavement to secure tents. Please bring weights. Drilling will result in a \$250 fine and removal from the festival.

If your booth is a trailer, the tongue to the trailer MUST FIT within the confines of your booth space. If it extends beyond that perimeter, you will need an additional booth space. For pedestrian safety, no trailer tongues may extend out into pedestrian walkways at the ends of each row.

We respectfully request that vendors refrain from smoking or vaping within the confines of their booth due to the close proximity with other vendors.




#### Please Provide the Following:

- 1. Vendor application (See attached or go to www.cowetachamber.com).
- 2. Copy of your current Certificate of Insurance valid through September 13, 2025. Your COI must have the Coweta Chamber of Commerce as a certificate holder.
- 3. A photo of your booth display showing the items you sell.
- 4. List of all items to be sold at Coweta Fall Festival. We will not accept your application without this list. Items offered for sale at the event that are not on the list may result in your expulsion from the event without refund.
- 5. Copy of current Oklahoma sales tax permit (unless otherwise exempt). If you are exempt, please note on the application and attach a copy of the exemption letter.
- 6. A completed Itinerate Vendor's License Application for the City of Coweta (no cost for festival).
- 7. Signature on contract and release of claims.
- 8. Payment. We accept credit cards, money orders, cash or checks made out to Coweta Chamber of Commerce. Payment is due at time of application. If you are not accepted as a vendor, or all spots are full, we will return your payment. Payments can be mailed to Coweta Chamber of Commerce, P.O. Box 70, Coweta, OK 74429 or dropped by our office at 115 S. Broadway in downtown Coweta. For payment by phone, call 918-486-2513.

Applications must include all of the items above, including payment, to be complete. We will number them in the order received and will fill spaces accordingly. Space is limited, so apply early. We reserve the right to reject any application for any reason.

The Coweta Chamber of Commerce cannot guarantee item exclusivity. Other vendors may sell like or similar products.

#### Vendor Set Up

Vendor booth set up will take place Wednesday, Sept. 10 beginning at 3 p.m. until 3 p.m. Thursday, Sept. 11. Your vehicle MAY NOT be parked on Broadway after 3 p.m. Thursday.

#### Space Assignment

Your space assignment will be emailed to you one week before the festival. The chamber reserves the right to reassign and redesign any space when it will enhance traffic flow and appearance of the festival. Electrical needs will determine where booths are ultimately located due to electric restrictions.

#### **Refund Policy**

Cancellations must be made in writing and postmarked by August 22, 2024. We issue a 100% refund if cancelled in writing by that date. No refunds for cancellations after August 22. No refunds will be made for weather at any time.

#### Electricity

All vendors who use electricity must supply their own extension cords to the nearest electric panel.

#### Restrictions

No weapons of any type are allowed to be sold. This includes pocket knives. Any toy guns, including marshmallow shooters, MUST have an orange tip attached to it. Items that make taser noises are allowed, but must not show lights or arcs like a taser. No merchandise with sexual content, profanity or otherwise offensive in nature can be displayed. No food (unless in sealed packaging) and/or drinks can be sold from vendor booths. THERE ARE NO EXCEPTIONS TO THESE RESTRICTIONS.

#### Proper Clean Up

It is expected during and after Fall Festival that you leave your assigned space(s) as you found it. Any cardboard boxes you empty MUST BE BROKEN DOWN and discarded in the trash dumpster on the southwest end of food alley by the Kinetic/Windstream building. This is the only dumpster you should use. DO NOT USE DUMPSTERS BEHIND BUSINESSES OR ELSEWHERE IN THE ALLEY WAY. A \$50 trash fee will be billed if your area is not cleaned. All vendors must be cleared out by 2 a.m. Sunday, Sept. 14.

#### NO TEAR DOWN OR LEAVING UNTIL 11 P.M. SATURDAY

The Coweta Fall Festival operates until 11 p.m. Saturday, Sept. 13. To ensure the safety of our festival patrons, vendors MAY NOT tear down their tents or remove their booths until the festival closes. Electricity will be turned off at approximately 1 a.m. Sunday, Sept. 14. Please be patient when leaving.

I am responsible for my own displays, tables, chairs, backdrops, signs and extension cords for electricity. I WILL NOT drill into the pavement to secure my tent(s). Drilling will result in a \$250 fine and removal from the festival without refund.

I will operate my booth in a safe manner. I agree to maintain booth cleanliness and will keep my area neat and pleasant for customers. A \$50 Trash Fee will be billed after the festival if the area is not cleaned.

I understand that no food (unless in sealed packaging) and/or drinks may be sold from vendor booths. If I am not selling under the Oklahoma Food Freedom Act, I will be required to acquire a temporary license from the Wagoner County Health Department.

Absolutely no weapons of any type are allowed to be sold. No merchandise with sexual content, profanity or otherwise offensive nature can be displayed. There will be no exceptions to these requirements.
